- 2. Nearby Landmarks & Transportation**
 - **Lukiškės Square:** A prominent public space in Vilnius, situated near the venue.
 - **Vilnius Old Town:** A UNESCO World Heritage site, renowned for its well-preserved medieval architecture, cobblestone streets, and vibrant cultural scene.
 - **Gediminas' Tower:** A historic symbol of the city offering panoramic views of Vilnius.
 - **Vilnius Cathedral:** A prominent landmark and the main Roman Catholic Cathedral of Lithuania.
 - **Public Transport:** The nearest bus stop to Vasario 16-osios g. is Lukiškės, approximately a 2-minute walk away.
 - **Trolleybus Access:** The Žaliasis Tiltas trolleybus station is about a 6-minute walk from the venue.
